

Student Email! Network! Blackboard! Messenger!

Resource Login Information

Beginning with the Fall 2008 semester, all MCC students will need login information in order to access certain student resources. Login conventions will be the same for all systems listed below. Students will need to know their Student I.D. Number for a successful login.

Username:

All usernames will utilize the following naming convention – first initial (of your first name), last name, last two digits of the Student ID Number.

[For example, if your name was Bob Student and your Student ID# was 0123456, your username would be bstudent56]

Password:

All passwords will utilize the following naming convention – first initial (of your first name), last initial (of your last name), and last four digits of the Student ID Number.

[For example, if your name was Bob Student and your Student ID# was 0123456, your password would be bs3456]

Where Can I Find My Student I.D. Number?

The Student ID Number appears on your schedule, listed as “ID Number”, or it can be found on the back of a Student Photo ID. It is a seven (7) digit number.

******Computers in Library and Open Computer Lab:**

You will need to login to the network in order to use internet resources in these two areas of campus. Beware! For security purposes, if there is no activity after a period of time on a PC, the system will automatically log you out.

Your username and password will be the same as the email and Blackboard login.

******GroupWise Student Email:**

Every student will be provided an email account. You can access it through the web from anywhere at <http://mccmail.montgomery.edu>. Your username and password will be the same as the network and Blackboard login.

******Blackboard:**

If you are in an online course or if your traditional classroom uses Blackboard as a resource, you will need a login. Your username and password will be the same as the network and email login.
