

Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) Requirements

1. MUST MEET WITH THE BLET DIRECTOR: You may make an appointment by calling 910-576-6222 Ext. 244 or E-mail herronp@montgomery.edu. PLEASE SET UP MEETING AS EARLY AS YOU CAN!
2. Must be a US citizen and provide a copy of your Birth Certificate or Naturalization Certificate.
3. Student can be a minimum of 19 years old, BUT must turn 20 years old before the class ends to be eligible for admission.
4. Must provide an official high school or GED transcript.
5. Must score at least a 10th grade reading level on Reading Assessment exam.
6. Must have a VALID NC DRIVER'S LICENSE and provide a CERTIFIED NC driver's history.
7. Must obtain sponsorship from a NC public law enforcement agency.
8. Must NOT have a FELONY conviction. Certain misdemeanors may also disqualify. The BLET Director will review these for you.
9. Must have CERTIFIED copy of your CRIMINAL HISTORY from all counties/states you have resided in since the age of 16 years old. (If you are a MILITARY VETERAN you must provide a copy of your DD 214 and a criminal history from the branch of service you were a member of.
10. Must get a medical exam to be recorded on forms provided by the BLET Director.

IMPORTANT: Your FIRST STEP after contact with Student Services is to CONTACT THE BLET DIRECTOR. You will be given an appointment for a meeting where the program will be explained fully and you will be given various forms and instruction so you can complete the documentation process LISTED ABOVE to be accepted into BLET.

You will be given a date that will be prior to the registration date when all documentation must be turned in!

NOTE: Please start EARLY! Some out-of-state and military documentation can take time.
