Career Technical Education Eligibility Requirements

High school juniors and seniors must have a minimum unweighted high school GPA of 2.8 or must demonstrate college readiness on an approved assessment in English, reading, and math. Juniors and seniors who do not meet the GPA requirement and whose scores do not meet the required minimum scores on the assessment tests may request a recommendation of the high school Principal/designee and MCC's VP of Instruction or VP of Student Services to waive the GPA requirement. A CCP Enrollment Recommendation form must be on file at MCC.
