A score of 600/higher on the enew (March 2016 and beyond) SAT Math and a grade of C/higher in the NC Standard Course of Study Pre-Calculus course or an equivalent course from another state. 7. A score of 27/higher on the ACT Math and a grade of C/higher in the NC Standard Course of Study Pre-Calculus course or an equivalent course from another state. 8. A score of 560/higher on the SAT Subject Test in Mathematics Level 2.
